## STANDARD Check-In

Campers who have any **balance due** go to the “STANDARD” sign at the Chalet.

NOTE: It’s not too late for **EXPRESS Check-In!** Call or login within five days and prepay all camp fees.

**DEPARTURE:** All sessions end with a super fun *Closing Rally* beginning with the “Video of the Week” (new!) and ending with an action-packed program on the Steps of Faith. Parents, siblings, and friends welcome! Upon conclusion, all campers return to cabins for a final check out. **IMPORTANT!! Campers must be picked up by an authorized adult (PHOTO I.D. required) no later than one hour after the Closing Rally start time.** The TRADING POST will open beforehand for those who wish to avoid the post-Rally rush!

**CABIN ASSIGNMENTS:** Every reasonable effort is made to honor cabin mate requests (limit two per person). Keep in mind that campers are generally housed by the same grade or one grade apart. Group networks larger than four may be divided at Camp’s discretion in order to provide the best cabin environment for every camper. Thanks for your understanding in this complex process.

### DECORATING FUN

(IMPORANT: Be sure to check with mom or dad first!)

**THINGS NOT TO BRING:** Electronic devices (e.g. cell phones, computers, iPods, games, etc.), expensive jewelry, toy guns, magazines/comics, skateboards, rollerblades, illegal drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, fireworks, weapons, and gum.

**Note: Cell phones are not allowed during Camp.** We fully understand a parent’s desire to stay in contact with his/her child; however, we have found cell phones to be a distraction during the session. Further, cell phones pose liability issues for Camp and camper safety. For these reasons, we require campers to (1) leave their cell phones at home (preferred!), or, (2) turn them in at check-in. If you have questions about communicating with your child during the session, please call the Camp office.

**DRESS CODE:** In seeking to create a wholesome and uplifting environment, setting standards for clothing can become a source of tension. While “less is more” may be a popular fashion, inappropriately-dressed campers will be discreetly instructed to change. **Clothes to leave at home:** spaghetti straps, leggings (unless covered by shorts), yoga pants, short shorts, revealing or tight-fitting tops, crop or halter tops, tube tops, clothing with offensive designs, shorts/pants with lettering on seat, two-piece and revealing or cutout one-piece swimsuits. *General rule: if in doubt, leave it out.* Thank you for your cooperation!



**SPENDING MONEY:** TRADING POST (garments, blankets, jewelry, toys, and other novelties), CANTEEN (candy, ice cream, snacks, soft drinks), CRAFTS, and MISSIONS OFFERING. Most program events are free, but a few have fees: SCREAMIN’ EAGLE ZIPLINE (\$5 per ride, second ride FREE; must be at least 10 years and weigh 60 pounds or more); and PAINTBALL (Junior High & Senior High only: \$12 per session, \$5 for refills). All spending money is to be turned in to the “Camp Bank” at registration and Canteen Cards are held by the Office for safekeeping. Most accounts average from \$15 to \$40. Unspent money is refunded on the last day of camp.

**ALL CAMP PHOTO / “REPLAY” DVD:** Reserve an 8 x 10 all-camp color photo for \$5 (distributed the last day of camp). The photo includes a fun CAMP LEBANON bookmark. If ordered in advance, the *Replay* DVD slide show is \$6 (\$8 at Camp) and features the “Video of the Week,” cabin photo, and bonus pics! PRE-ORDER AS A SET FOR \$10 AND SAVE!



**MISSIONS PROJECTS:** A Camp tradition, Closing Rally missions love offerings have raised over \$126,000 in the past twenty years to bless a camp in Ukraine as well as other mission projects. **2017 goal:** \$7500. Thanks for your help!

**PHONE CALLS / VISITS:** Camp leadership understands the great responsibility assumed in caring for your children. Phone calls (incoming or outgoing) and visits disrupt the camp schedule and may affect camper morale and, thus, are not normally allowed. ### DIRECTIONS FROM:

**TWIN CITIES:** I-94 to Albany. North on MN 238 thru Upsala. Left on Cty 228 for 3.5 miles. Follow signs to Camp. (See **Road Construction Warning** below)


**ANOKA:** US 10 north past St. Cloud to Rice. Left Cty 2 for 3 miles across river. First right (to North Prairie) 17.5 miles to Upsala. Right on MN 238 thru town. Left on Cty 228 for 3.5 miles. Follow signs.

**ALEXANDRIA:** 1-94 to Sauk Centre (Exit 127). North on US 71 to downtown. East (right) on Cty 17 for 12 miles to “T” intersection. North on Cty 35 (becomes Cty 47) 4 miles. East on Cty 2/F for 7 miles past Cedar Lake. Turn north (left) on 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue and follow signs to Camp.

**LONG PRAIRIE:** From US 71 east on MN 287 to Grey Eagle. South on Cty 33 (Todd 2) for 9 miles past Cedar Lake (on the left). Turn north (left) on 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue and follow signs to Camp.

**LITTLE FALLS:** West on MN 27 one mile out of Little Falls. Turn south on MN 238 to Cty 228 north of Upsala and head west for 3.5 miles. Follow signs to Camp.
