- Level 1 Classes teach basics of quilt making, including accurate measuring, rotary cutting and machine piecing. This level is great for first-timers and beginners who desire a firmer foundation of quilting tools and methods. Instructors guide with step-by-step instructions from start to finish.
- Level 2 Designed for those who have experience in basic cutting, plecing and finishing techniques. Classes focus on a specific pattern or technique.
- Level 3 Reserved for those who possess a broad grasp of quilting techniques. Accurate sewing is essential. Classes focus on teaching specific pattern and often involve intricate and precise piecing methods. Participants generally work on their own with instructor assistance available.

The Lemonade Stand (Levels 1 & 2)

This fun project is perfect for first-time quilters and those wishing to establish a firm foundation of

quilting basics. Instructors guide step by step with group instruction and personalized assistance. PATTERN: \$5 (prepay with registration).

LEVEL 1 - Includes basic blocks for beginners. Upon completion of this quilt project, you will be on your way to more quilting fun!

LEVEL 2 - Block options for intermediate quilters: If this is <u>not</u> your first quilt, you have the option of replacing one or more of the nine patch blocks with alternative 9+ block variations that give you the opportunity to try more advanced, complex piecing.

Fabric Suggestions: This lovely quilt pops with color! Use ten Fat Quarters, or combine a few Fat Quarters with lots of scraps for variety. Try pastels or bright prints or 30¢ reproduction fabrics with white background fabric. Or, choose bright batiks or solids with black background fabric.



Trail Mix (Level 2)

Trail Mix snacks for some might best be described as %M & Mos õ with obstacles!+With this Trail Mix quilt, simply colors you love, work with accuracy, and your Trail Mix will be a delicious treat without any obstacles at all! Instructor assistance is provided.

Fabric Suggestions: Pick 12 different Fat Quarters that have some contrast, but coordinate. Then, select one fabric for the narrow border around the nine-patch block and inside the square-in-a-square block. This fabric might be a background fabric that shows off the main fabrics, or an accent fabric that stands out against the main fabrics. PATTERN REQUIRED: \$5 (prepay with registration).



Sessions A, B, C, D: \$65 - Come any time Thurs after 10 AM. Fee includes 5:30 dinner on Thursday plus Friday breakfast and lunch.

REFUNDS: Full payment required to save your spot (includes nonrefundable \$50 deposit). No refunds after February 1 unless spot is filled.
