



\* Scrapbookers are welcome any session! Scrapbooking supplies and instructors are available only during Session D. Cricut machines available all sessions. Level 1 Classes teach basics of quilt making, including accurate measuring, rotary cutting and machine piecing. This level is great for first-timers and beginners

who desire a firmer foundation of quilting tools and techniques. Instructors guide with step-by-step instructions from start to finish. Level 2 Designed for those who have experience in basic cutting, piecing and finishing techniques. Classes focus on a specific pattern or technique.

Level 3 Reserved for those who possess a broad grasp of quilting techniques. Accurate sewing is essential. Classes focus on teaching specific pattern and often involve intricate and precise piecing methods. Participants generally work on their own with instructor assistance available.

#### Avalanche (Level 1)

The perfect project for first-time quilters and those wishing to establish a firm foundation of guilting basics! Instructors will guide step by step with group instruction and personalized assistance. Upon completion, you will be well on the road to other quilt projects! PATTERN: \$5 (prepay with registration); mailed with confirmation packet.





#### Magical Stars (Level 2)

Magical Stars uses 1/4 yard cuts and Tri Recs Tool to create stars that truly sparkle. This guilt by local designer Ruth Anne Cheney (Pierz MN) is also a great stash buster with two size options provided in the pattern. Confident beginners and intermediate guilters welcome for this class! TRI RECS TOOL REQUIRED (purchase on your own) PATTERN REQUIRED: \$10 Magical Stars by Quilting on the Curve.

### Irish Eyes (Level 3)

Irish Eyes twinkle back at you as this stunning 67" x 85" quilt is assembled. Instructors will concentrate on teaching this specific pattern and the two specialty rulers used: Thirtysomething Ruler & Tri Recs Tool. This Level 3 class is designed for those who have made several quilts and have a firm foundation of quilting basics. Prework and accurate seam allowances are needed. PATTERN: \$5 (prepay with registration); mailed with



confirmation packet. RULERS REQUIIRED: Thirtysomething Ruler & Tri Recs Tool. Purchase rulers on your own; available online or in shops.

CABINS: (By request only) Reserved for individuals and groups desiring a more private sleeping area. Cozy units with shower house nearby. Standard twin beds. Linens available.
