## **Year-End Gifts Launch '19**

Exactly 102 donors contributed over \$50,000 in year-end gifts, matching our goal and launching Camp's 2019 ministries. Coming off a record year with 11,201 year-round guests, expectations are running high, especially for summer youth camps. The generous donations will help fund significant projects in the months ahead, most notably Phase II of the Beaver Point Board Walk. We'll also be finishing the Chalet deck and adding crucial maintenance and food service equipment. Thank YOU for standing with and behind us in this great work!

Who stole the deck off the Chalet on February 2? Was it the 150 women on site for the Winter Warm Up? Actually, they weren't bothered at all by the work and stayed far, far away. Was it the Camp Board, who met the same day to work on Camp's 2019 budgets? They "talked" about the project and approved the \$55,000 needed to finish it. That was enough for them! The real "criminals" were 15 volunteers (8 men and 7 boys), who, on a perfect, sun-kissed day (+30!), worked like the carpenter ants and finished the tear-off and clean-up by dinner. Their efforts saved \$6000 in the process and set the stage for local carpenters to start building the new, composite deck on February 11.
