Record Year-End Donations Launch New Year!



After a wild, challenging 2020, what does 2021 hold? Thankfully, that question can be left at throne of the Sovereign King. One known fact: Camp is starting the year on solid financial footing thanks to Almighty God's provision through the incredible generosity of friends and church partners. In December alone, 321 donors contributed over \$142,000 in donations, including \$8818 from an estate gift and \$114,544.50 from over 200 special year-end donations. Contributions ranged from \$5 to \$25,000, the average topping \$440. "It's both humbling and inspiring," reflects Executive Director Bill Abeler. "Back in April, we were staring at a \$600,000 crater and, thanks be to God, Camp finished in the black. The goal was to build a bridge to next summer and we're half way there!" In reflecting back over 2020, three truths stand out. First, God continues to have big plans for advancing His kingdom through the ministries of Camp Lebanon. Second, Camp's friends desperately want to see the ministry continue. And third, leadership is encouraged to move forward with planning for spring, summer, and beyond! In fact, plans are coming together to build the North 40 gym, Lord willing, in 2021. Stay tuned!

Camp Reopens for Winter Ministry

The Governor's mid-November mandate to close public accommodations like Camp Lebanon was devastating - for guests and staff! Sadly, that ruling shut down the last two sessions of Fall Quilt, which featured six retreats and the 30th Anniversary Celebration of an amazing ministry. Fall ministries had already been reduced in size and several groups cancelled altogether. With the winter in doubt, annual favorites, like Mega Fun, YAR Winter, and Women's Winter Warm Up, were taken off the schedule. Such was the end of a difficult and faithstretching year. Ah, but did you hear the big "WOO HOO!" that boomed from Camp later in December? Local health officials reopened Camp for winter retreat ministries, albeit in a modified format involving changes in food service, guest groupings (called "pods") and large group gatherings.
