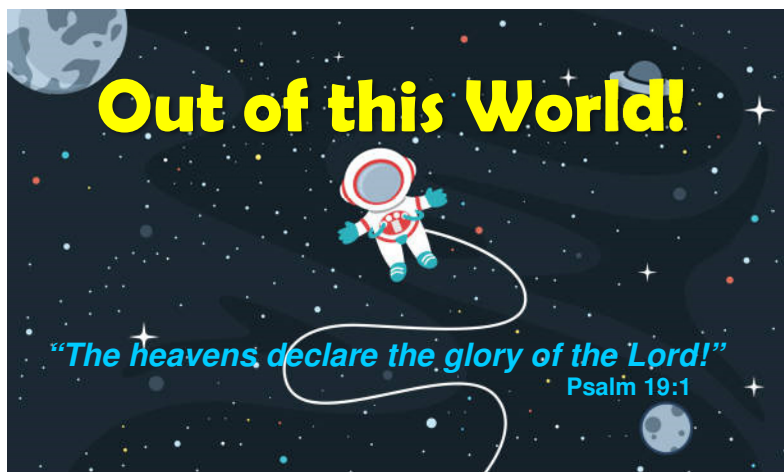

Level 1 Classes teach basics of quilt making, including accurate measuring, rotary cutting and machine piecing. This level is great for first-timers and beginners who desire a firmer foundation of quilting tools and methods. Instructors guide with step-by-step instructions from start to finish.

Level 2 Designed for those who have experience in basic cutting, piecing, and finishing techniques. Classes focus on a specific pattern or technique.

Level 3 Reserved for those who possess a broad grasp of quilting techniques. Accurate sewing is essential. Classes focus on teaching specific pattern and often involve intricate and precise piecing methods. Participants generally work on their own with instructor assistance available.

Star Trekking Fun! Venture with us into a “quilter’s galaxy of starry delights” as you enjoy creating these projects! Guided class instruction will focus on Fractals and Seven Sisters projects.

Fractals Quilt Class (Level 1)

This is a great project for first-time quilters and those wishing to establish a firm foundation of quilting basics! This quilt is a fun way to show off focus fabrics and special prints or add creative embellishing with appliqued designs using Camp’s Accuquilt machine. Instructors guide step by step with group instruction and personalized assistance. Upon completion, you will be ready to venture into other quilting projects! **FREE PATTERN** (sign-up on registration); mailed with confirmation packet.



Seven Sisters Quilt Class (Level 1+)

Named after the Pleiades star cluster, this original design by Jan Sands is simply out of this world! This easy-to-piece pattern is a great choice for beginners making their second or third quilt. Advanced quilters will love it, too! The challenge may be limiting your fabrics to only three favorites! You can orbit your way around that by making each “sister” block in a different fabric! A “half-sized” version of this quilt is also available. **PATTERN: \$10** (prepay with registration); mailed with confirmation packet.

Number the Stars (Level 1+)

Sparkling stars float effortlessly amidst Irish Chain blocks to create a dazzling effect in this simple yet stunning 59” x 77” quilt. This advanced beginner or intermediate pattern by Lisa Abeler combines Terry Atkinson’s fabulous *Lucky Star* technique with a variation of the traditional Single Irish Chain block. You’ll receive the *Lucky Stars* pattern (pictured below) by Atkinson Designs along with the Number the Stars pattern. **PATTERN: \$10** (prepay with registration); mailed with confirmation packet.



Desert Stars: Atkinson Designs (All levels!)

This easy table runner was inspired by the twinkling stars in the desert sky. Use 5” charm squares to make simple stars or fat eighths (9” x 21”) to make the sampler stars. Finished size: 12” x 44”



Villa Rosa “Super Star Trilogy” - 3 great patterns for \$5!



Cloud Nine – One of our favorite patterns for beginners! Advanced quilters will also love this quick and easy project. Choose 12 fat quarters that you love, one yard of background fabric, plus 5/8 yard for binding.

Stargazer – Bold stars accented with smaller stars. Use contrasting fabrics to make them really stand out and shine.

Solar Flare – Half square triangles make it easy to piece together this fat quarter friendly quilt. With dynamic color movement, this radiating star is one of the most popular Villa Rosa designs of the past year.

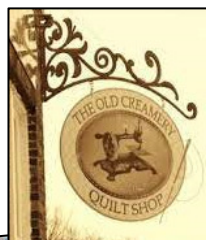

This compact yet roomy bag is perfect for daily necessities, biking, or travel. The convenient sling design and adjustable strap allows for easy access plus keeps it out of the way when you're not using it. Make it with waxed canvas, Pendleton or your own fabric. **Pattern: \$10**

MOTHER / DAUGHTER SPECIAL

Daughters ages 13-18 may attend any session with mom (or a responsible adult such as grandma, aunt, youth group leader) at a reduced fee. *Each daughter comes for only \$99 for weekend stay; extra day \$50.* Machine spaces are reserved for both mom and daughter. Mom can work on own projects but is expected to assist daughter.

Enjoy extra time to sew! Come any time after 10 AM.

First Camp meal is 5:30 dinner; also includes Friday breakfast and lunch.

MIDWEEK SESSIONS

All Midweek Sessions end with Show 'n Tell breakfast, lunch, and relaxed afternoon departure.

2022 FEES Fee includes meals, housing, program, and classes.

REFUNDS: Full payment required to save your spot (includes non-refundable \$50 deposit). No refunds after January 31 unless spot is filled.

Send a **\$50 non-refundable deposit** when registering to reserve your spot and attach a note requesting the Financial Assistance application. *Do not allow finances to be the reason for not attending!*

WHAT TO BRING: Bedding, mattress pad, pillow, towels, toiletries, flashlight, earplugs, informal clothing, project supplies, sewing machine, IRON, extra lamp, chair & cushion, uncompleted projects, Bible.

THINGS TO LEAVE AT HOME: Media players, side tables, alcohol.

WORKSTATIONS: Friends will be stationed together. We provide padded chairs but strongly suggest you bring your own comfy chair with chair pad, wheels, and height adjustment.

HOUSING: CEDAR BAY LODGE/BIRCH POINT: 18 units sleep 4-5 adults (XL bunk, XL reg. double, rollaway), full bath. **CHALET:** 6 units sleep 4-8, private vanity, community showers, elevator access, handicap friendly.

SCANDINAVIA: 6 units sleep 3-7, adult beds, community showers. **CABINS:** (By request only) Reserved for individuals and groups desiring a more private sleeping area. Cozy units with shower house nearby. Standard twin beds. **ROOM ASSIGNMENTS** are made to maximize group experience and factor in project, stay, and roommate requests. Sorry, private rooms are not available, except in cabin housing.

LINENS: Linen rental includes sheets, ONE blanket, pillow, pillowcase, and towel set. Linen fees: \$10 (Linens with 1 towel set) or \$12 (Linens with 2 towel sets.) **TWO-WEEK NOTICE APPRECIATED.**

CHILDREN: Daughters age 13+ may attend any session with mom or an adult. We are not able to accommodate babies.
