How are you keeping track of your goals?

An adult will be helping me keep track of my goal progress. It's really important that I actually do the activity and send the donations to Camp by Tuesday, September 6th.

What is the Kids Love Camp-A-Thon?

The Kids Love Camp-A-Thon is the name for a youth fundraiser to help build Camp's new gym. Some kids will raise money by giving out of their own savings or by earning money doing chores, setting up a Lemonade Stand, or selling cookies. Others will organize their own fun Thing-A-Thon. The sky is the limit! Together, the cumulative Camp goal is to see if kids can raise \$25,000 for the new gym.

When are donations due and when will the prize drawings be held?

All donations are due at Camp by Tuesday, September 6th. The grand prize and ultimate grand drawings will be made as a part of the Fall Senior Day at Camp on September 13th.

Why ask kids to help build the new Gym?

For one thing, kids love Camp! Involving kids in the gym project will help them grow a healthy sense of ownership in their Camp. What's more, it's also a fun way to teach kids the joy of giving. The Bible teaches that God is a giver and something very special happens when people of any age share in His generosity. Plus, it's also a fun summer project for kids that doesn't involve being on a computer screen.

Are my gifts tax deductible?

As an IRS recognized 501c3 non-profit organization, donations are tax deductible as allowable by law. All donations made online will be receipted via email. Camp will also issue emailed receipts for cash gifts over \$25 if email address information is provided on the Pledge / Donor Form.

Creating a Personal Fundraising Webpage

1) Go to this website URL: https://bit.ly/3xTCIIU

This will bring you to a sign up form. Enter your email, name, and password. Click Submit! Once you do this, you'll be taken to the next step where you can set up your page details.

NOTE: An email will be sent asking you to confirm your account.

2) Create Your Page & Add Details

1) Set your fundraising goal, 2) Set a "Team Name" (i.e. Bobber Bill's Fish-A-Thon), 3) Write your own mission statement, 4) Add an event date, and 5) set a feature image or video.

NOTE: We highly recommend setting a feature photo or video.

3) Now You Have Your Own Page!

Looking good! You can update & edit details on this page when you're logged in. At the top you'll see "Enter Pledge." When someone makes a pledge or gives you a cash donation, write it on your Pledge/Donor Form first and then enter it in here to show your progress toward your goal. Next, click on "Public Page" at the top of your screen.

4) Sharing Your Page & Make Online Donations!

When you click "Public Page" you'll go to a page you can share with friends & family. Copy the URL at the top of the page or use the social media share buttons to invite more people to help you reach your goal. People can easily donate online on this page and you do not need to add them to your Pledge Form.
