Level 1 Classes teach basics of quilt making, including accurate measuring, rotary cutting, and machine piecing. This level is great for first timers and beginners who desire a firmer foundation of quilting tools and techniques. Instructors guide with step-by-step instructions from start to finish.

Level 2 Designed for those who have experience in basic cutting, piecing, and finishing techniques. Classes focus on a specific pattern or technique.

Level 3 Reserved for those who possess a broad grasp of quilting techniques. Accurate sewing is essential. Classes focus on teaching specific pattern and often involve intricate and precise piecing methods. Participants generally work on their own with instructor assistance available.

WEEKEND CLASSES (A, B, C, D, E)

Yellow Brick Road (Level 1)

Yellow Brick Road is perfect for first-time guilters and those desiring a firm foundation in guilting basics. This well-written, easy-to-follow pattern by Atkinson Designs has been one of the best-selling patterns in the world for the last 20+ years! This class will teach the lap size quilt, but the pattern has multiple sizes. A separate Mini Brick Road table runner pattern is also available. Instructors will guide step by step with group instruction and personalized assistance to help you create this



quilt. Upon completion, you will be well on your way to enjoying other quilt projects! PATTERN: \$10 Yellow Brick Road by Atkinson Designs. Please pre-register for this class: pattern will be mailed with confirmation packet.

Diamond Jubilee (Level 2)



With bursting displays of color, this breathtaking quilt pattern is a perfect way to celebrate Camp's 75th "Diamond Jubilee" anniversary! This modern throw-size quilt pattern is made up of two distinct blocks - a scrappy star block and a diamond block - set in an alternate layout. The pattern has easyto-follow instructions and diagrams and is easy enough for a confident beginner. It's also 2-1/2" precut strip friendly, so choose your favorite roll of fabric, add background yardage, and enjoy the simply stunning results! This pattern can also work with 2-1/2" squares if you love a scrappy quilt.

PATTERN REQUIRED: \$10 - Download the pattern in either as a PDF or digital download from the http://MondayMorningDesigns.com Etsy website.

Baby Bella (Level 2 – This class starts Friday @ 9:30 am)



Baby Bella is an adorable variation of a miniature lone star with eight "rays" of diamonds extending from a center star, framed by a sawtooth border and cornerstone stars. Baby Bella was designed by Judy Niemeyer to introduce quilters to paper piecing techniques. Paper piecing is the most accurate way to piece complex patterns. Judy Niemeyer's patterns along with the foundation papers by Quiltworx simply take the guesswork out of the process. All seams are straight without Y-seams or curved seams.

NOTE: Baby Bella is a beginner level paper piecing project; however, class participants should be confident in their basic quilting knowledge and experience.

PATTERN REQUIRED: Call Pine Needles Quilt Shop at (507) 226-8480 to purchase the pattern (includes Instructions, yardage information, and foundation papers to make a 36" x 36" quilt. A Quilt Instructor will contact you prior to retreat to assist with preparation and fabric selection.

A Latte Fun with Decorative Stitches



THURSDAY EARLY BIRD: Enjoy extra time to sew!

\$75 - Sessions A, B, C, D, E - Come any time after 10 AM. First Camp meal is 5:30 dinner. Also includes Friday breakfast and lunch.

MIDWEEK SESSIONS All Midweek Sessions end Tuesday with Show 'n Tell breakfast, Grab 'n Go Lunch, and relaxed afternoon departure.

2022 FEES Fee includes meals, housing, program, and classes.

REFUNDS: Full payment required to save your spot (includes non-refundable \$50 deposit). No refunds after August 31 unless spot is filled.

Send a **\$50 non-refundable deposit** when registering to reserve your spot and attach a note requesting the Financial Assistance application. *Do not allow finances to be the reason for not attending!*

WHAT TO BRING: Bedding, mattress pad, pillow, towels, toiletries, flashlight, earplugs, informal clothing, project supplies, sewing machine, IRON, extra lamp, chair & cushion, uncompleted projects, Bible.

THINGS TO LEAVE AT HOME: Side tables, alcohol ... dishes, laundry, worry!

WORKSTATIONS: Friends will be stationed together. Each 6-foot table is shared by two people. We provide padded chairs but strongly suggest you bring your own comfy chair with chair pad, wheels, and height adjustment.

HOUSING: CEDAR BAY LODGE/BIRCH POINT: 18 units sleep 4-5 adults (XL bunk, XL reg. double, rollaway), full bath. CHALET: 6 units sleep 4-8, private vanity, community showers, elevator access, handicap friendly. SCANDINAVIA: 6 units sleep 3-7, adult beds, community showers. CABINS: (By request only) Reserved for individuals and groups desiring a more private sleeping area. Cozy units with shower house nearby. Standard twin beds. ROOM ASSIGNMENTS are made to maximize group experience and factor in length of stay and roommate requests. Sorry, private rooms are not available, except in cabin housing.

LINENS: Linen rental includes sheets, ONE blanket, pillow, pillowcase, and towel set. Linen fees: \$10 (Linens with 1 towel set) or \$12 (Linens with 2 towel sets). *TWO-WEEK NOTICE APPRECIATED.*

CHILDREN: Daughters age 13+ may attend any session with mom or an adult (Quilt E age 11+). *Each daughter only \$125 for weekend stay; extra day \$50.* Machine spaces are reserved for both mom and daughter. Mom can work on own projects but is expected to assist daughter. *Sorry, we are not able to accommodate infants.*
