


THINGS TO BRING: Bible, informal attire. favorite table game, a favorite promise of God to share, and a friend or two.

DIRECTIONS FROM:

TWIN CITIES: 1-94 to Albany. North on MN 238 thru Upsala. Left on Cty 228 for 3.5 miles.

ANOKA: US 10 north past St. Cloud to Rice. Left on Ctv 2 for 3 miles across river. First right (to North Prairie) 17.5 miles to Upsala. Right on MN 238



ALEXANDRIA: 1-94 to Sauk Centre (Exit 127). North on US 71 to downtown. East at light on Cty 17 for 12 miles to 'T'. North on Cty 35 (becomes Cty 47) for 4 miles (Big Birch Lake on left). East on Cty 2/F for 7 miles past Cedar Lake (on left). Follow signs to Camp

LONG PRAIRIE: From US 71 east on MN 287 to Grey Eagle. South on Cty 33 for 9 miles past Cedar Lake.

LITTLE FALLS: MN 27 west to MN 238 south to Cty 228 north of Upsala. Follow Cty 228 for 3.5 miles.
